The Head, CHES(IIHR), Bhubaneswar on behalf of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, New Delhi invites tender for disposal/sale of mango fruits of 2713 Nos. of specified mango trees, Sapota fruits of 200 Nos of sapota plants and pineapple fruits of more than 1500 Nos of pine apple plants through tender-cum-auction. The details of varieties of Mango fruits, Sapota fruits, Pine apple fruits to be disposed off through tender-cum-auction are mentioned below, subject to the specified terms & conditions.

<p>NOTES: Harvesting of fruits has to be done in the presence of the designated office staff for collecting yield data. The tenderer should inform the farm section of their intention to harvest a particular plot/variety at least one day in advance so as to make necessary arrangements for recording yield data and collecting fruit samples. Following quantity of fruits are needed by the Station and the tenderer will have the right for remaining quantity only.</p> <p>*Total No. of bearing trees to be auctioned excludes earmarked painted mango trees in different blocks. These marked trees are exclusively for research purpose.</p> <p>Pine apple fruits of Dashehari plot, Langra Plot and Row No.2 & 3 of Amrapalli & Mallika plots are not included for tender/auction .</p> <p>Research Requirement:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fruits of all varieties (Mango) : 5 kg (each) (For mango field day and research purpose) 2. Fallen Damaged fruits of each variety 3. Fruits of Mango Germplasm : 2 kg fruits of each plant are required for research purpose. 			

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. Auction of Mango fruits are for the aforesaid specified varieties only and total No. of plants are 2713, Sapota fruits of 200 plants, pineapple fruits of more than 1500 plants.
2. The above specified varieties/area of Mango, sapota and pineapple to be auctioned may be inspected on any working day between 10.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. with the permission of Farm In-Charge of this Station. The number of fruiting trees out of the total number being offered for tender/auction and the expected yield may be assessed by the tenderer.
3. The tenderer is informed to quote their offer price in the prescribed format only enclosed in FORM No.1. The Committee may go for direct bidding from among the participants who have submitted their tender for auction of mango, sapota and pineapple fruits, if the offered price is not equal to reserve price or more.

4. **EARNEST MONEY:** The earnest money of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) should be deposited by the tenderer in the form of crossed demand draft in favour of the CHES, BHUBANESWAR payable at Bhubaneswar. The tender will not be considered if the earnest money draft is not submitted with the tender. Request for transfer of any previous deposit of earnest money will not be entertained.
5. The tenderer is informed to submit the tender paper along with EMD DD signing in all pages about acceptance of terms and conditions by 5.00 P.M. on **Dt.26/04/2018. THE TENDERS, WHICH ARE RECEIVED ON TIME, WILL BE OPENED AT 11.00 HOURS ON 27.04.2018.**
6. **After opening the tender papers, if the maximum offered tender does not meet our reserve price, open auction will be adopted among the present representatives of the agencies participated in the tender process. The auction bid is to be held on Dt.27/04/2018 at 11.00 A.M. in the office of the undersigned at Aiginia Farm, Bhubaneswar.**
7. **Only one authorized person will be allowed to take part in the auction/tender process.**
8. **MODE OF PAYMENT:**
25% of the bid/tender amount is to be paid by the successful tenderer or auctioneer on the same day on which tender is opened and the balance 75% amount within 4 days from the date of auction. Payment of the 25% and the 75% of the amount as required may be made in cash or through e-payment/DD drawn in favour of CHES, Bhubaneswar. Failing, 0.5% will be charged per day as penalty on the full amount.
9. Further, if the successful tenderer/auctioneer fails to comply with conditions stipulated above and at item at Sl.No.11, she/he has to forfeit the deposited bid amount and the EMD.
10. **RIGHT TO ACCEPTANCE:** The Council reserves its absolute right to accept or reject the whole or part of any tender or portion of the rate quoted. If felt necessary, the rates may be negotiated through auction by the Committee with the tenderers present at the time of opening of tenders.
11. **Agreement & Security Deposit:** The successful tenderer should execute an agreement on a non-judicial stamp paper worth of Rs.20/- and also deposit 10% of the bid amount as security deposit within 4 days from the date of auction. The security deposit along with the EMD amount will be refunded only after the satisfactory completion of the contract, on receipt of written request thereafter.
12. The EMD of the unsuccessful tenderer will be refunded after the highest tenderer complete all the legal formalities mentioned in item No.11.
13. **Watch and Ward:** Watch and ward arrangement should be made by the successful tenderer immediately after the award of contract and the station would not be responsible for the theft and damage by natural calamities or fire etc, thereafter.
14. **Harvesting of mango, sapota, pine apple fruits are to be carried out by the contractor or his labourers in the presence of our farm staff.**
15. **Sale of fruits must not be done within campus and in front of Main Gate area.**
16. Farm operation required to be carried out will be continued and the contractor will have no right to interfere with the regular farm operations.
17. The successful tenderer on receipt of work order from the Head and deposit of full auction amount, shall be entitled to enter into the specified area for harvesting of mango fruits.
18. **The successful tenderer must submit the name and details of required personnel to be engaged in collection of mango, sapota and pine apple fruits inside the campus. Only those authorized personnel will be allowed inside the campus.**
19. No other trees except the earmarked area mango, sapota and pineapple trees be harvested or damaged on any account.
20. He shall have no right to the land, other trees, permanent structure and on other assets of the CHES inside the plantation during the period of such temporary possession excepting the right for harvest of mango, sapota and pine apple fruits.
21. Any loss, damage or pilferage of other property including plantation caused by him or his workers shall be personal responsibility of the tenderer/contractor, which will be recovered outright.
22. The CHES/Council shall not be held responsible for any damage and or loss due to any climatic hazard, fire hazard or any natural calamity during the contract period and the tenderer is debarred from claiming refund of any amount, either in full or in part on these accounts.

23. He shall be personally and severally liable to compensate the loss or damage if any caused to other trees, the land or any other assets of the Station inside the plantation during harvesting of mango, sapota and pine apple fruits within the contract period as would be assessed by the Head, CHES and the same may be deducted from the refundable security deposit of the contractor.
24. The CHES official and staff shall have the right to go round the plantation to inspect the same and carry on such cultural operations as may be considered necessary by them or take observations during the contract period.
25. The CHES shall not bear any responsibility legal or otherwise for breach of peace, litigation or any public vandalism inside the plantation if occurs at or during the course of harvesting of mango, sapota and pine apple fruits within the tender period.
26. At the same time, CHES will take appropriate action if peace and discipline of the campus are broken by the tenderer at any point of time during the auction period.
27. The responsibility of harvesting of fruits rests with the tenderer without any damage to the trees at their own cost and remove with their own means.
28. **The tender period will end by 20th June.** However, if required this may be extended with prior approval of Head, CHES. The tenderer and his personnel will leave the campus as soon as the tender period is over.
29. **They should not carry any prohibited items into the campus.** The tenderer will be allowed to carry out his activities during the normal working hours of the station (9.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M.)
30. In case of unavoidable circumstances viz., declared holidays, bandh etc., the specified dates for various steps may be extended to the next working day for which notice will be displayed only at our office premises.
31. The produce except those, auctioned will not be allowed to be removed. In the case the highest bidder or his persons is found doing so the contract will be nullified and the money deposited for the purpose will be forfeited.
32. Firewood should not be used for cooking etc. in the orchard. If he and his persons are found doing so the contractor will have to pay the penalty fixed by the Head, IIHR-CHES, Bhubaneswar.
33. If any accident occurs due to the negligence of the contractor or his personnel, he/she will have to pay the damage cost fixed by the Head, IIHR-CHES, Bhubaneswar.
34. Any tax, if leviable, shall have to be paid by the successful bidder.
35. The contractor will harvest the fruits with the permission of the concerned Scientist engaged in research in the crop with gate pass from the field.
36. Quantum of fruits/plants required for research purpose given as above
37. **Arbitration:** In the event of any dispute of differences arising in connection with the tender, the same shall be referred to the Director, ICAR-Indian Institute of Horticultural Research, Bengaluru. The decision of the Director shall be final and binding on the parties.
38. Notwithstanding the above, the undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject tender or annul the tendering process and reject all tenders at any time prior to award of the contract, without assigning any reason, whatsoever and without incurring any liability of obligation, whatsoever, to the affected tenderer or tenderers.
